In the midst of difficult times, it's helpful to remember how resilient we can be, and how supporting each other strengthens us all. Based on the image of a tiny plant growing up through concrete (but that wasn't pretty to stitch!), I hope this little piece brings a smile when you need it. I am so grateful for you and for this stitching community – thank you.

This design has a stitch count of 91w x 59h and uses full crosses over two and a couple of backstitches. In my model, I used one strand of floss over two threads of linen. This design is suitable for Aida stitching too...

Model stitched on 32-count 'Cinnamon Sugar' by Paddock Lane Designs. I've finished it as a pin-pillow, but it would look equally lovely in a small frame. Visit my blog for more info on the design and for other goodies!

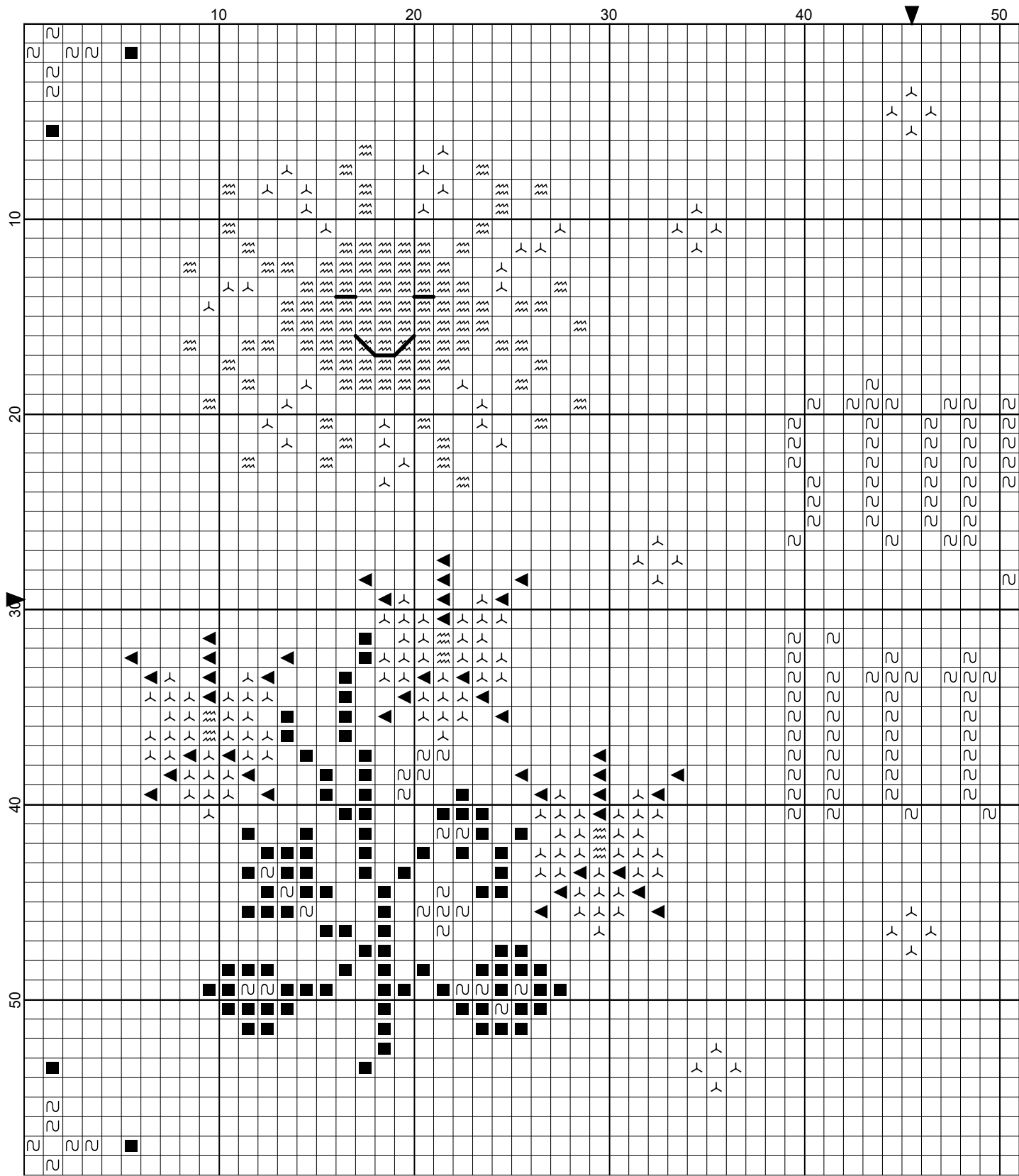

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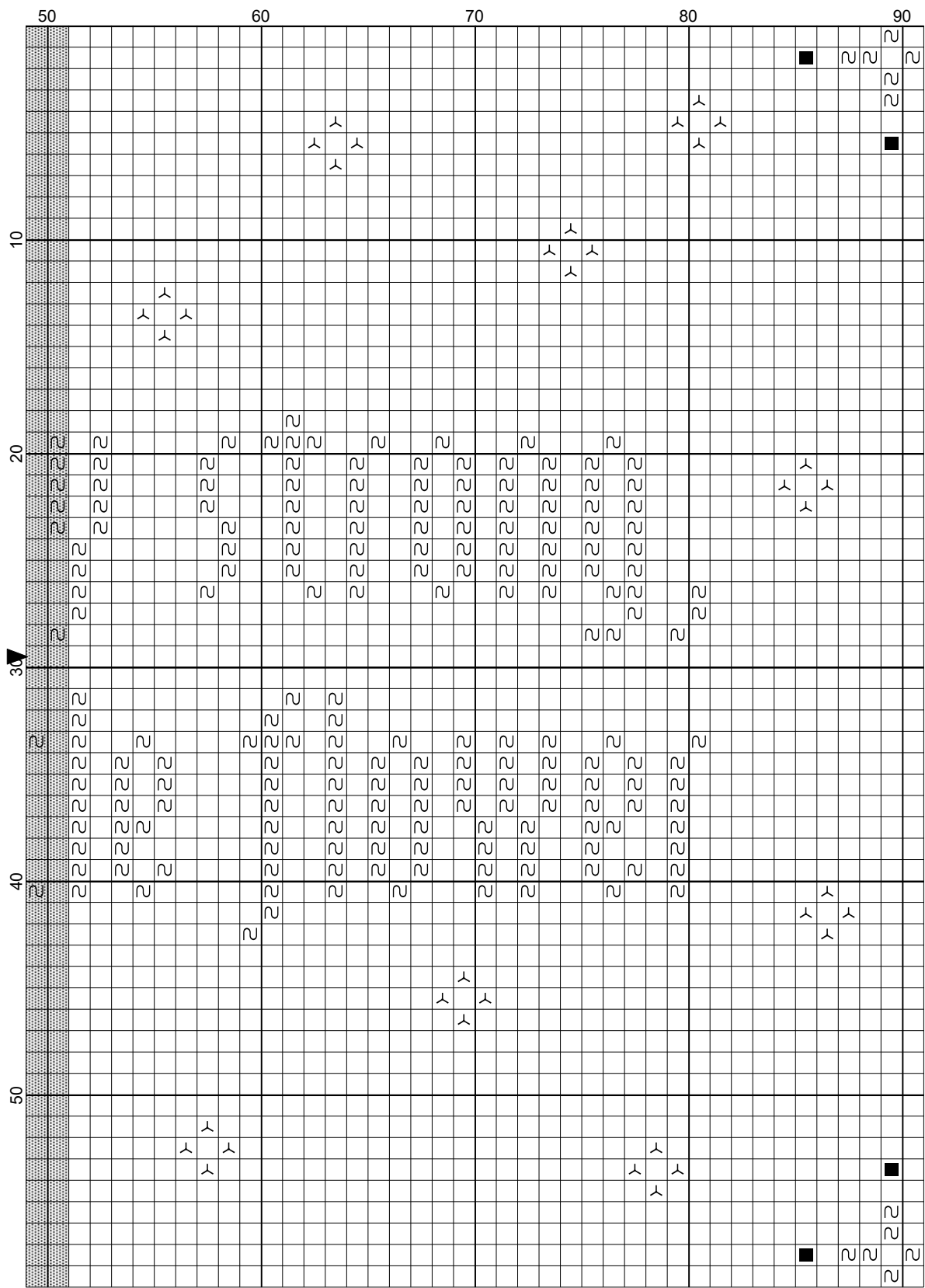

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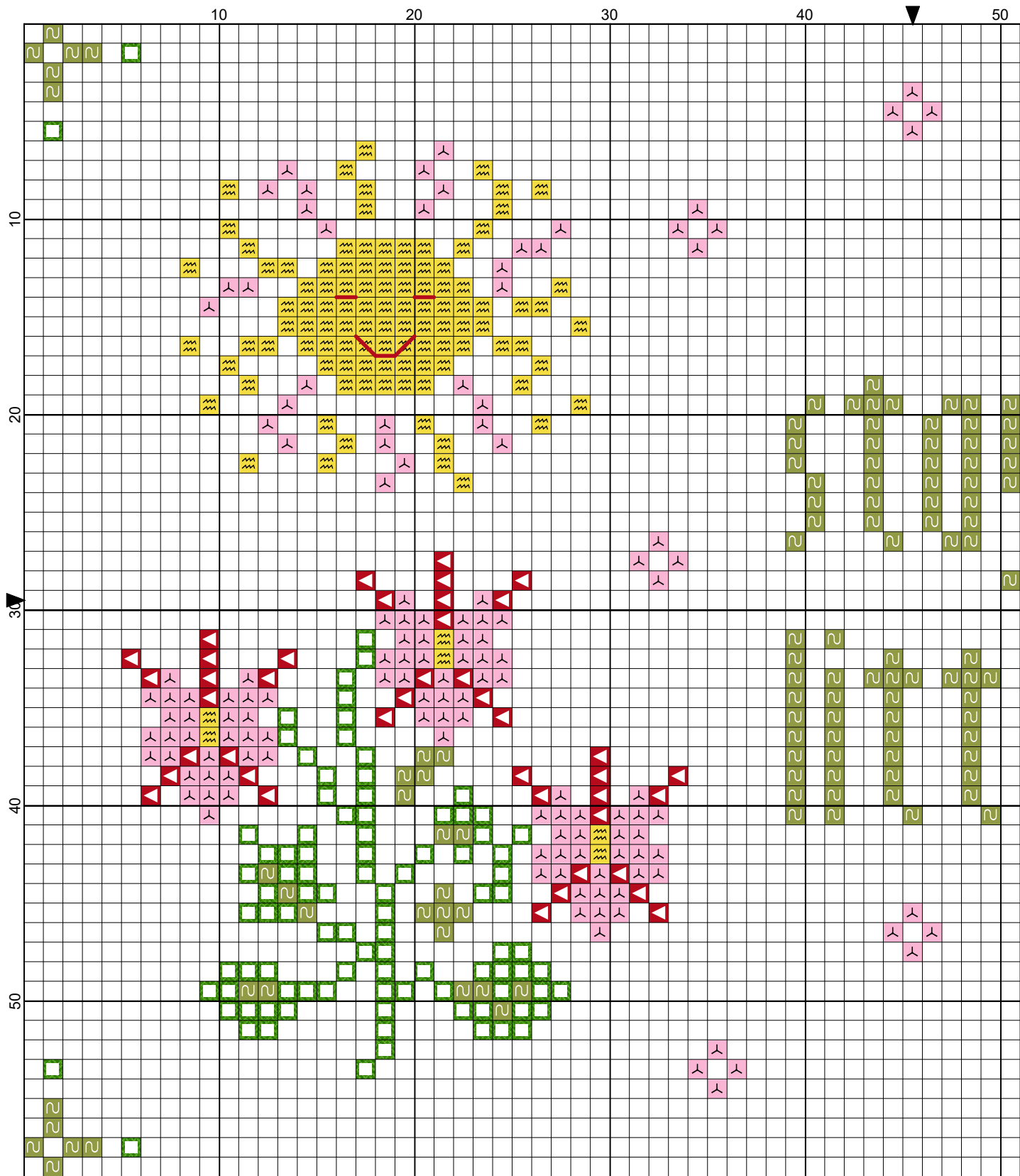


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Backstitches:

CGT-JK02 Leatherbound

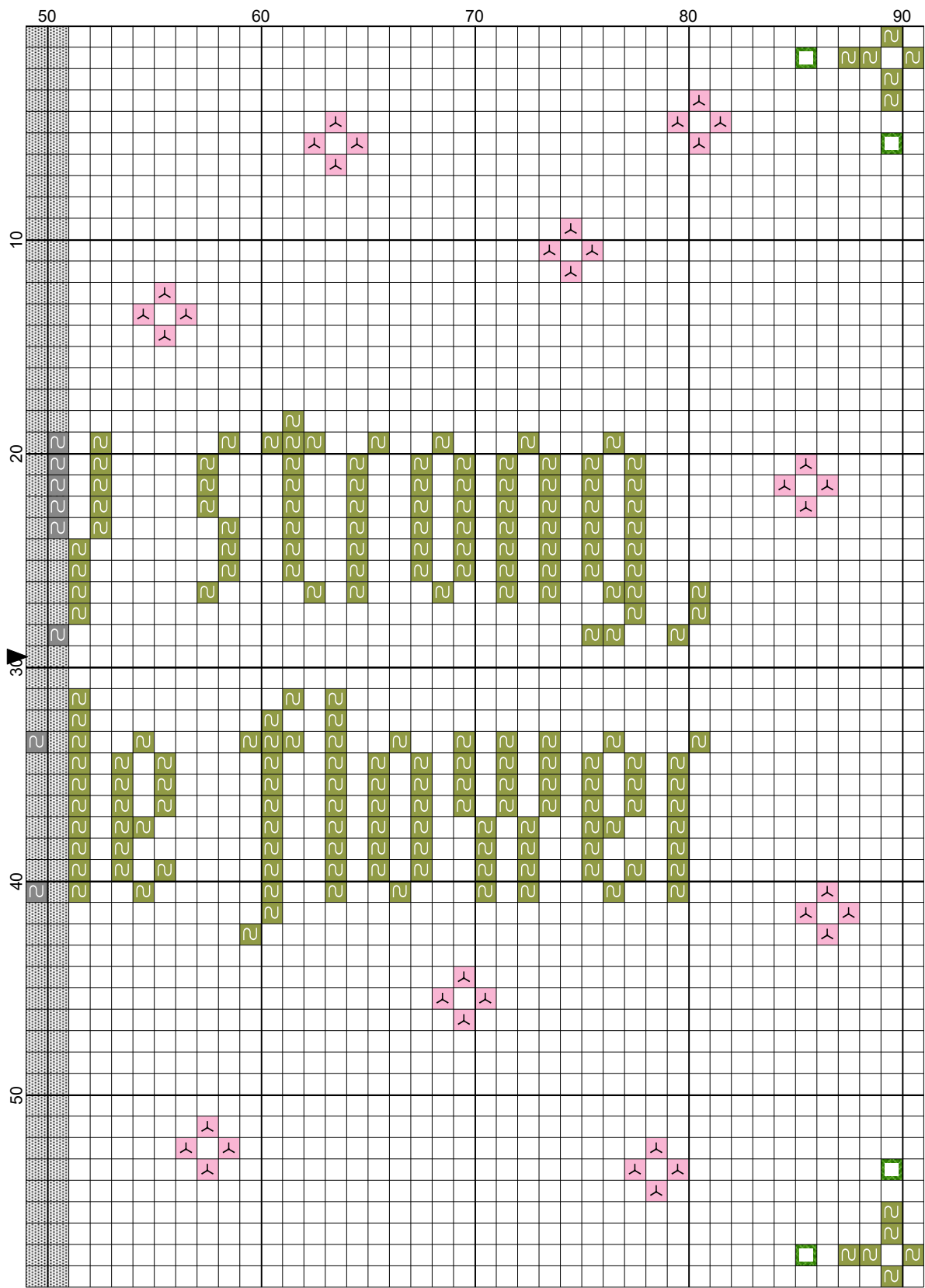
Stitching instructions: Stitch all cross-stitches first, then the back-stitches.
I used 1 strand for both, as I wanted a softer look. Use 2 for bolder colour.



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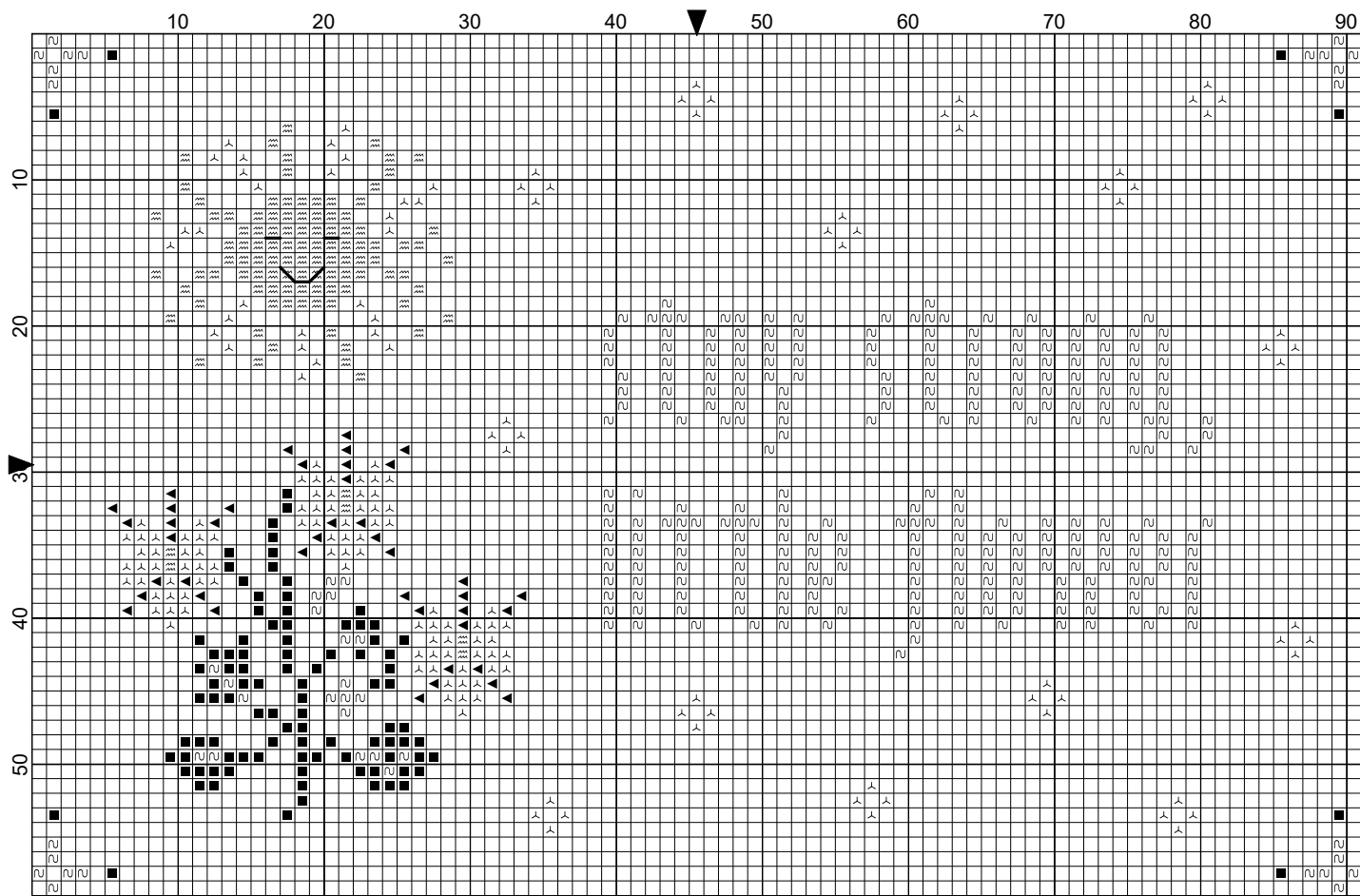


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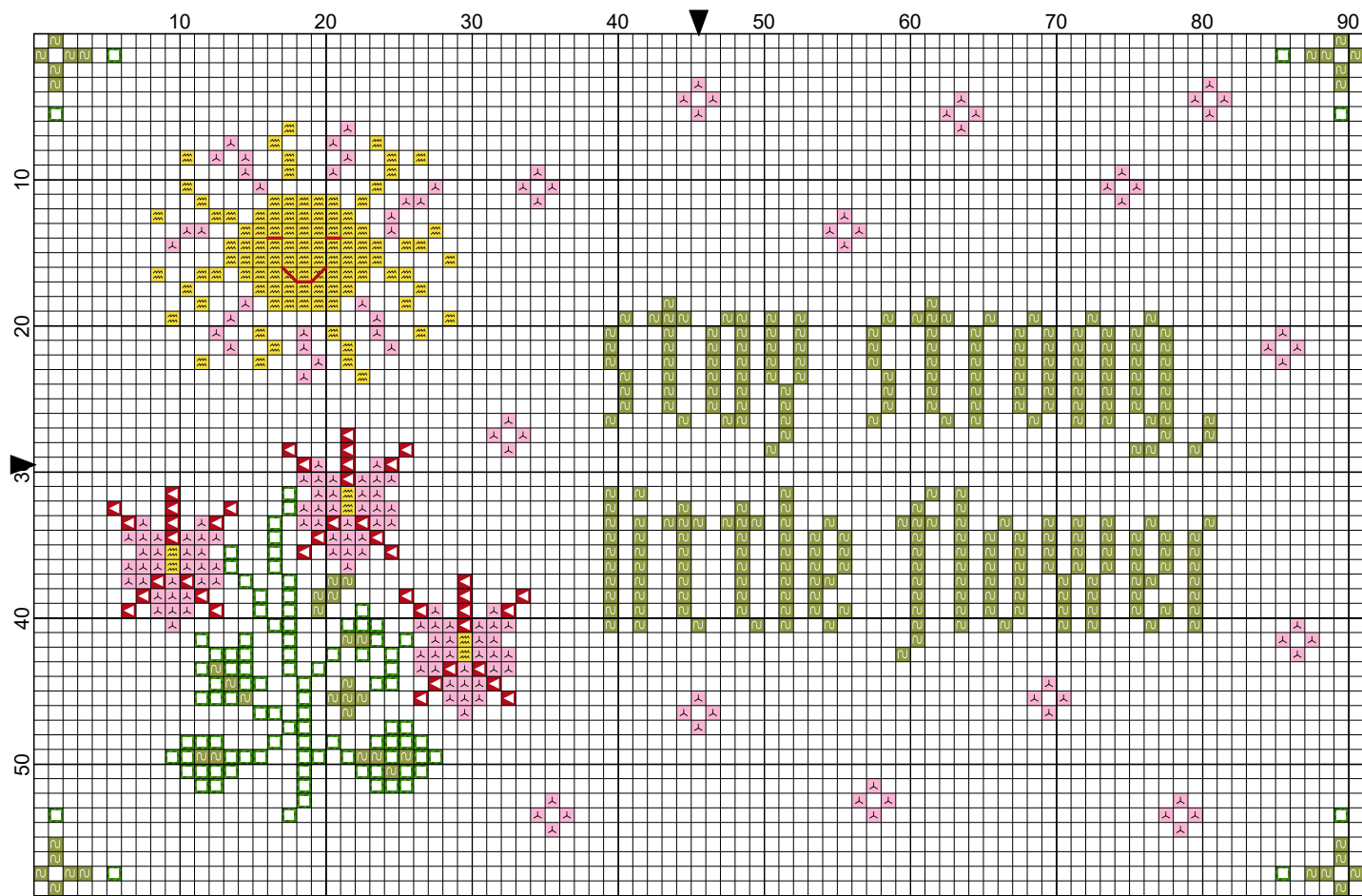
